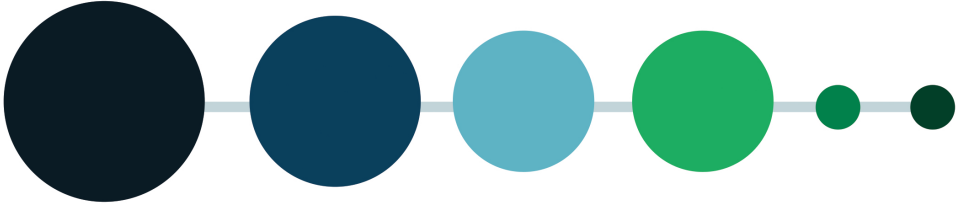

Investing in Patient Mental Health

PREPARING FOR SHIFTS IN MEDICAID

In 2018 Virginia became the 33rd state to adopt an expansion of Medicaid coverage for low-income adults. During the past year our Board of Directors and our clinic team invested a huge effort into looking at how these changes could affect our community and the patients we serve.

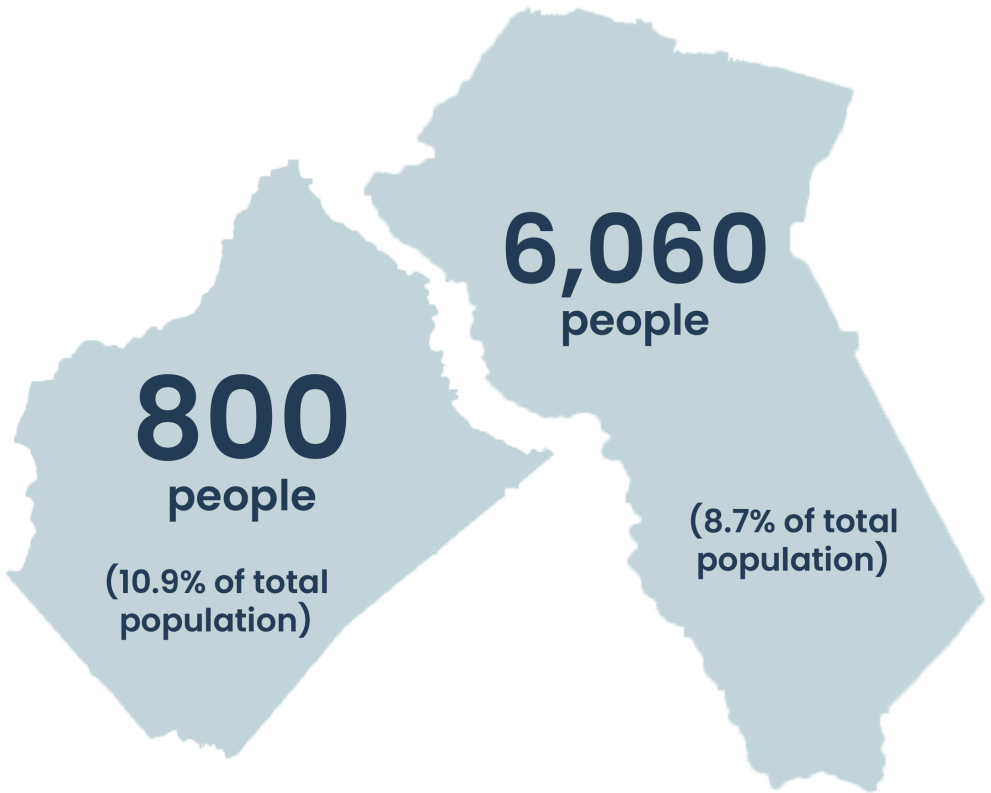
We found that a majority of our patients should be able to access this coverage starting in 2019, and furthermore that few local primary care providers have capacity to absorb them into their practices. Therefore we have begun the hard work of becoming credentialed providers ourselves at the Free Clinic.

“We took a hard look at who our patients are and what the community capacity is to meet their needs. We came to the conclusion that no other local facility can offer the same integrated health care, diagnostic and treatment options that we do. So many of the patients I see at the Free Clinic need to address chronic health conditions as well as mental health and oral health concerns. Going forward our medical team is committed to make sure they have what they need to be healthy. We have a lot of changes to make, but the care we provide is not changing at all.”

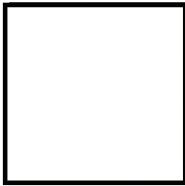
